### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The competition is open to all dancers within the age group on the day of the event, either on line or venue based.
2. Fees for entry and participation for each event are displayed on the DPA website. Login (ticket entry) is £15.00 plus 5.00 per dance per event. Entries will only be accepted via [www.enter2dance.com](http://www.enter2dance.com)
3. All participants and spectators must pre-register for the competition and in doing so, you are indicating your agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions
4. **All Participants must first read our online competition safety guidelines below. By taking part you are indicating your agreement to uphold the necessary safety precautions.**
  - a. Ensure you have a suitable space to dance. It should be a sufficient size for you to move freely and be clear of any obstacles.
  - b. You should make sure other people are at least two metres away from you to avoid injury. They must also not be visible on your screen.
  - c. You must warm up sufficiently before your competition.
  - d. You must be fit and well to compete.
  - e. Under 18's must not enter without parents consent or guidance.
  - f. Under 18's must be supervised AT ALL TIMES by a parent or guardian who will remain responsible for them for the duration of the event.
  - g. The promoter accepts no responsibility for any loss, injury or damage to you, persons around you, your property or your identity.
  - h. By accepting the terms and conditions, you are granting the Dance Promoters Association the right to use the photograph(s) and/or footage resulting from the competition, and any reproductions or adaptations of the photograph(s) and/or footage for all general purposes including, without limitation, the right to use them for TV, promotional films, online and in any publicity materials, books, newspapers, magazine articles and social marketing whenever the DPA chooses to do so.
  - i. If you are competing from your home or private residence, any personal items or personal information should be removed from view. Other precautions should be taken where deemed necessary to help protect your identity and the identity of those around you.
